From the East; Turn right (Petro Can) onto Bridge Street. Take next right onto Highway 5a. Go North for 800m veer right onto Old Hedley Road, go 300m turn left onto Princeton-Summerland Road. Go for 2.8km across bridge, Turn left @ Suppression camp sign.

From the West: Just past the A&W, turn left onto Bridge Street, Next right onto Highway 5a, Go North for 800m veer right onto Old Hedley Road, go 300m, turn left onto Princeton-Summerland Road. Go for 2.8km across bridge, Turn left @ Suppression camp sign.
