READ THIS CAREFULLY: Applicants must be certified BCTA Tracker (previously TK1) or higher. Applicants will be pre-screened for this course based on their qualifications and SAR Tracking and training experience as contained in their application form. New instructors will be given priority. The class size is limited to 8 applicants. All applicants must be current BCTA members and EMBC GSAR Volunteers. **Applications are due by 3 May.** Those selected/confirmed for the course will be notified by 10 May. Those not selected will also be notified. There will be a wait list in the event of cancellations.

Course starts: Sign-in Friday by 18:00. Class hours: Friday 18:00 to 22:00, Saturday 08:00 to 22:00, Sunday 08:00 to 15:00, (including breaks).

Course Fees: The BCTA has waived tuition fees.

Meals, Accommodation & Travel: Meals and accommodation will be provided during the course by BCTA. Travel funds may be limited to in-region applicants. Your GSAR Group has received training funding from BC SARA, including Tracker Training, so please request travel expenses from your GSAR Group. In-Region Current instructors in good standing may be reimbursed travel expenses. **New instructors will only be reimbursed travel expenses after they have taught one course.**

Accommodations: Shared, pre-booked by BCTA at Travel Lodge 2605 Cliffe Avenue, Courtenay. You will receive your room assignment and key when you arrive for registration.

Bring GSAR daypacks and be ready to conduct outdoor training in any weather conditions. Bring all your usual tracking gear plus GSAR logbook, notepad and pencil. Bring a laptop and your flash drive from previous instructor course. New instructors will be issued flash drives loaded with course materials.
