**Course Fees: \$225.00** (Non-refundable) for current BCTA members; \$450 for non-members. This covers course materials and Instructor remuneration. Fee will only be refunded if the course is cancelled.

**Bring GSAR daypacks and be ready to conduct training in any weather conditions.** Bring a sharp-focus flashlight (not a bulls-eye), tracking stick, tape measure, compass, notepad and pencil, safety glasses, energy snacks, and water bottles for in the field. GPS is optional but recommended.

**Terrace Search and Rescue Hall – Friday Classroom**  
(4455 Greig Avenue, Terrace BC)

**Onion Lake Ski Area** (Highway 37 at North Kitimat Forest Service Road)

From Terrace SAR Hall at 4455 Greig Avenue (Approximately 30 minutes)

- Go one block **North** from Greig Ave. and turn **Right** on to Lakelse Ave.
- Proceed **East** on Lakelse Ave. past the old bridge head **South** (towards Kitimat) at the roundabout intersection of Hwy 16 and 37.
- Proceed **South** on Hwy 37 to North Kitimat FSR (28.5 km from roundabout)
- Turn **Right** at Onion Lake Ski Trails sign, proceed 0.5km to parking area.
