Location: Campbell River SAR Hall, 261 Larwood Rd, Campbell River

Course Times: Sign-in and Registration Friday 19:00 Class hours: Friday 19:00 to 22:00,
Saturday 08:00 to 22:00, Sunday 08:00 to 14:00 (including breaks).

Course Fees: Tuition is \$225.00 (Non-refundable) plus a 1 or 3 year membership if you are in a SAR group; \$450.00 plus a 1 or 3 year membership for persons outside of SAR. Payment must accompany your registration form and be submitted at least two weeks prior to the course. This covers course materials and instructor reimbursement. The fee will only be refunded if the course is cancelled.

Meals: None, snacks will be provided at the hall throughout the weekend, but no full meals.

Accommodations: None, members are welcome to camp in the parking lot or sleep in the hall with bathroom access.

Equipment: Bring GSAR daypacks and be ready to conduct training in any weather conditions. Bring a sharp-focus flashlight (not a bulls-eye), tracking stick, tape measure, compass, notepad and pencil, safety glasses, energy snacks, and water bottles for in the field. GPS is optional, but recommended.

Membership: Memberships are good until December 31st of the year in which they were purchased. Memberships must be purchased 2 weeks in advance of the course from www.bctracking.org
1-year membership is \$15
3-year membership is \$40
